Swedish as a second language

Students must graduate with the IB Diploma subject Swedish A or Swedish as a second language 3 (SvA03) to qualify for entry to Swedish universities for degrees taught through the language of Swedish. Students do not require Swedish for entry to Swedish universities for degrees taught through English. Students without a grade in Swedish in Year 9 are not offered beginner Swedish lessons in Year 1 (Year 10) / Pre-Diploma year, and may take Swedish B SL ab initio (Swedish for beginners) in the two IB Diploma years.
